## Goals:

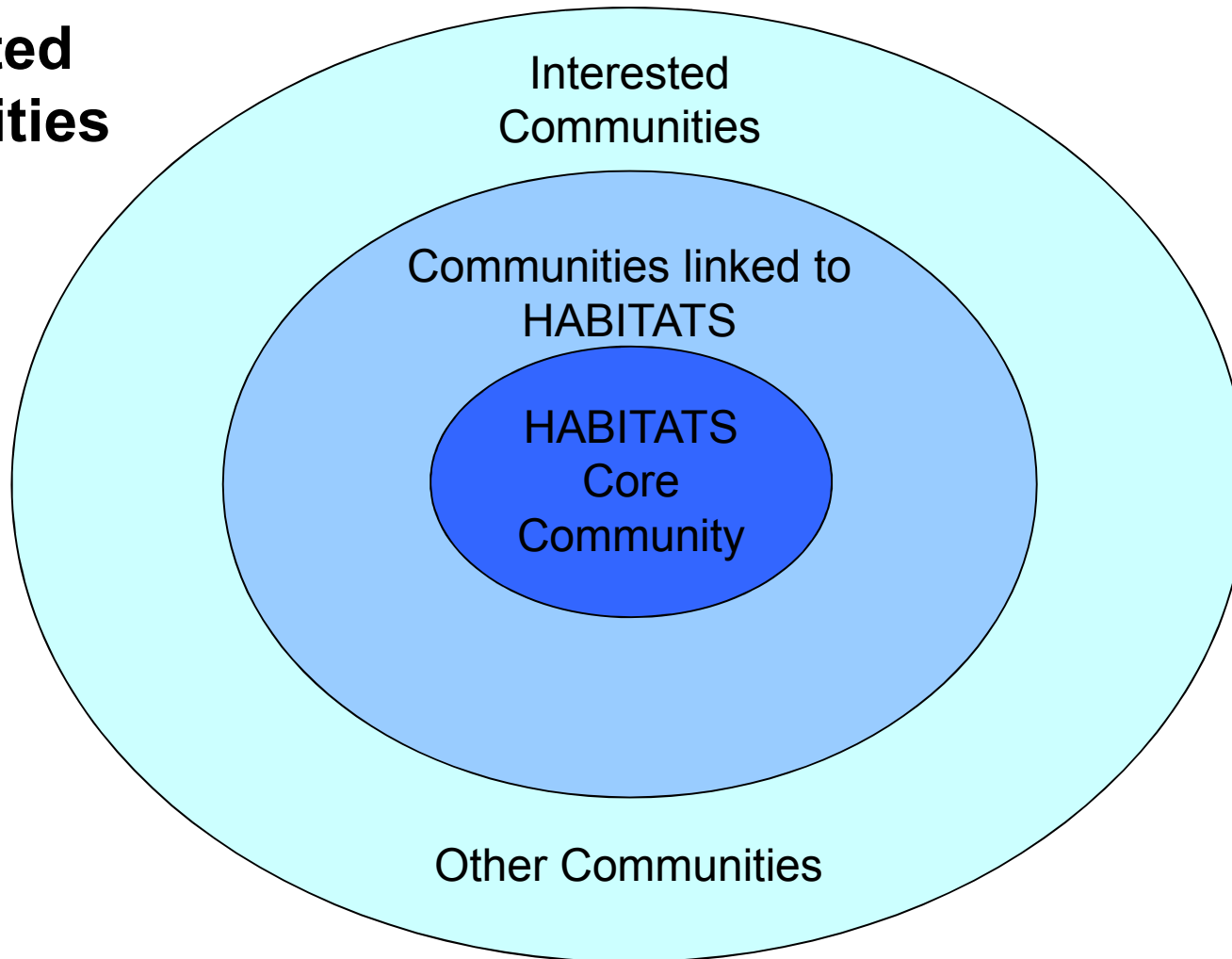
- Create a social network to consolidate the HABITATS user communities and structure the discussions

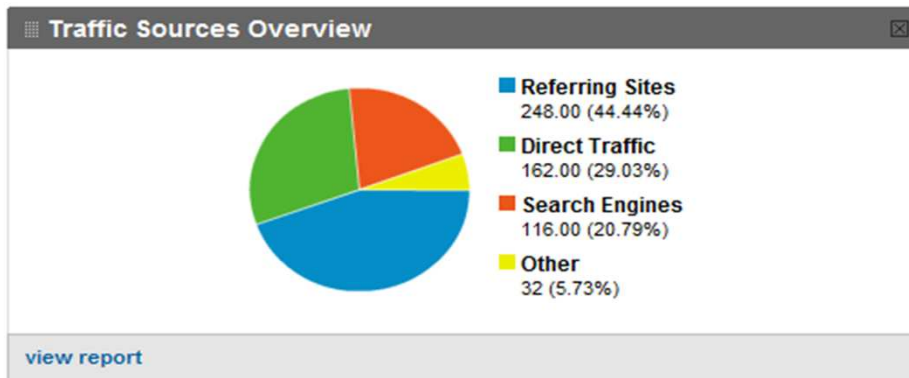
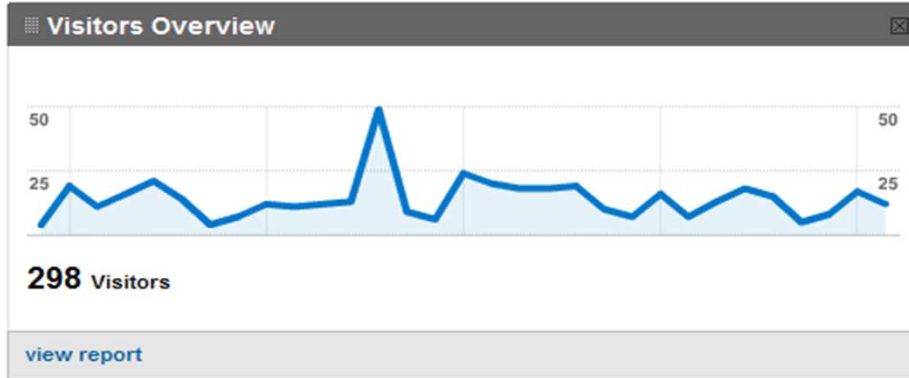

## Future developments
