What's going on?

- ongoing developments:
 - **Table Joining Services** (for on-the-fly merging statistical-PD with geospatial-SU data)
 - **GEOSTAT projects** – datasets and frameworks for georeferenced statistics (e.g. standardized population grid for Europe)
- events: conferences, workshops



How to implement?

- **download:** INSPIRE compliant GML examples
- **read:** discussions about the transformation process
- **talk:** network of experts involved in INSPIRE implementation in National Statistical Institutes

Something wrong?

- problem with the model, schemas etc?. **let us know!**
- several issues already solved:
 - wrong data types / typos in technical guidelines,
 - codelist uniformity,
- several issues pending:
 - usability of PD model,
 - alternative methods for PD data provision (e.g. SDMX)
