



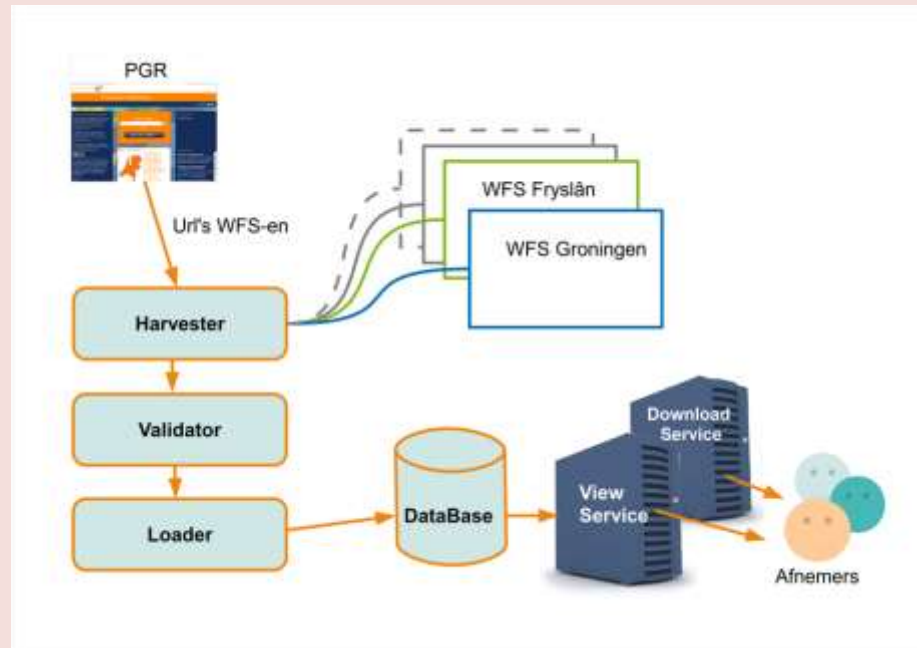

- The solution: CDS (2011)





Change needed, but why?

- Flexibility
- Efficiency

From a rigid, static INSPIRE-implementation

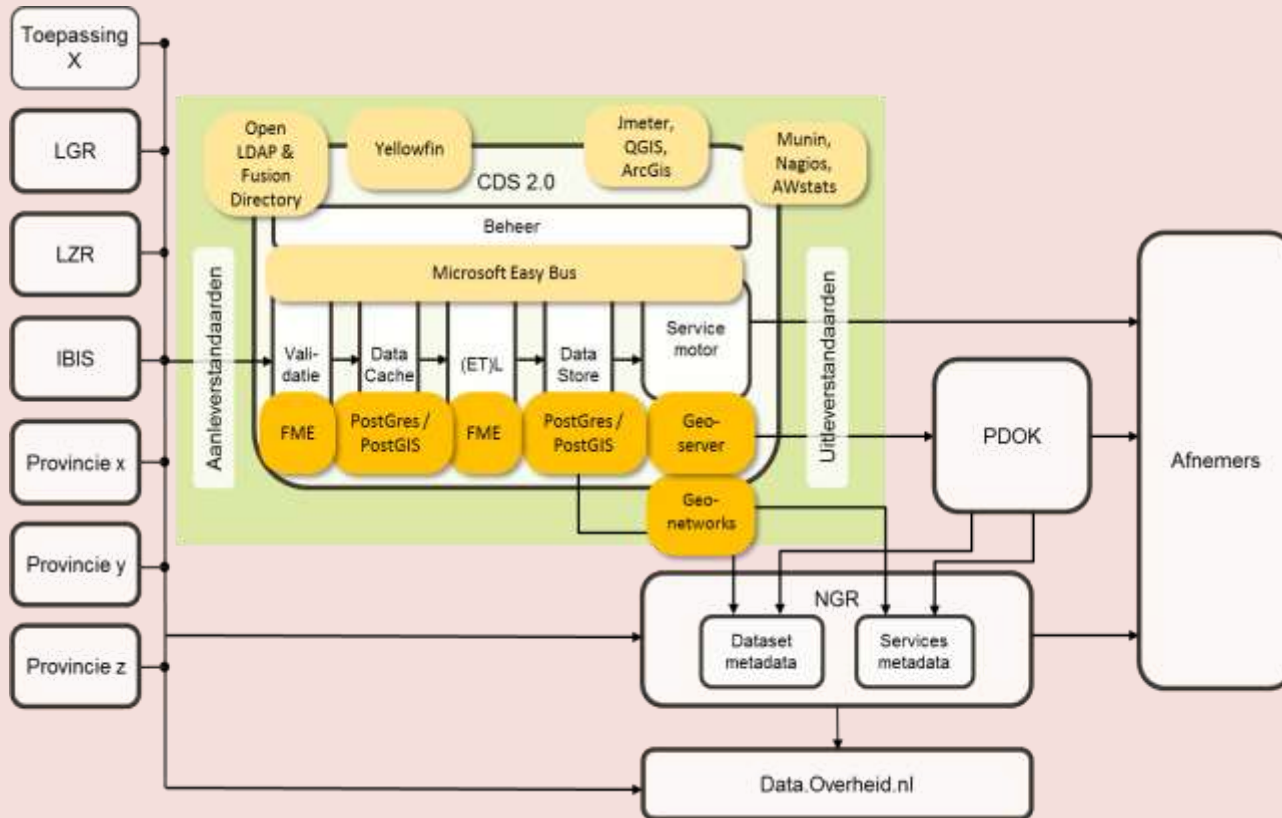
To a flexible system that can adapt easily to changing needs, applications and environment
