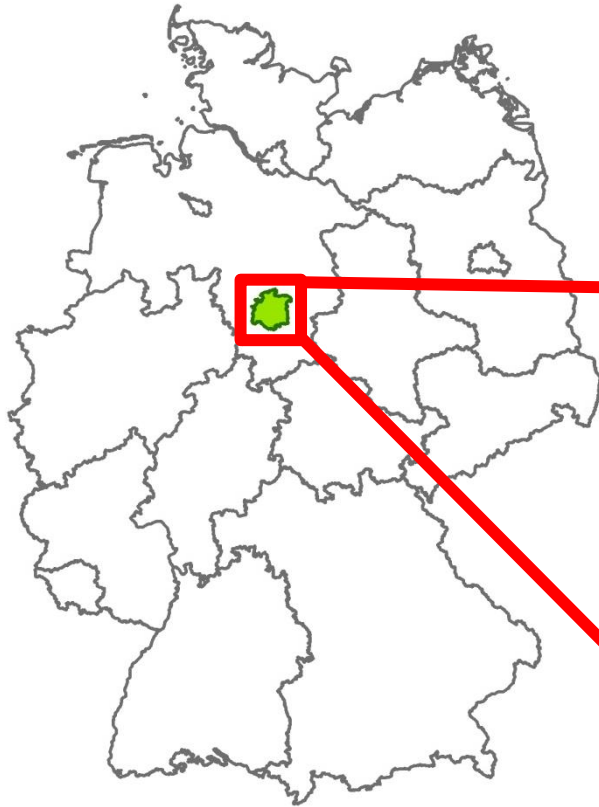

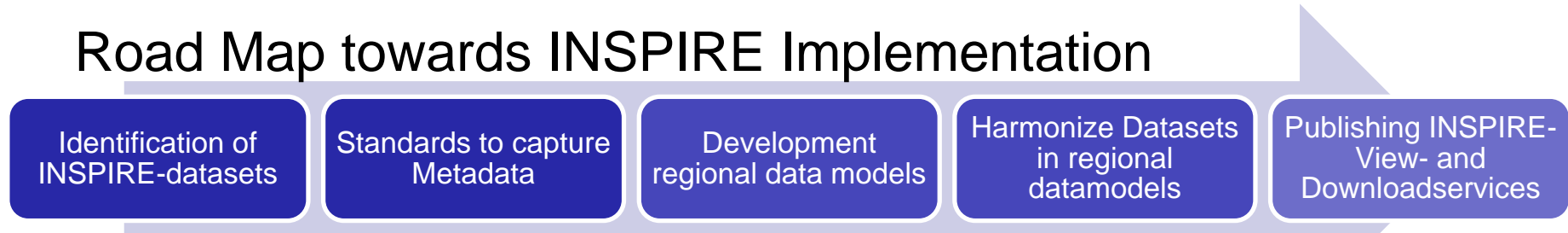


What is our solution?

- collaboration with county-affiliated towns and municipalities
- problem-oriented working group to implement INSPIRE

What is our solution?

Our organisational solution:

- (meta-)data published by the corresponding data-keeping-agency
- Working group develops:
 - Guidelines
 - Templates (metadata, datamodels)
 - Templates for data transformation
- Working group supports the local authorities



What is our solution?

Our technical solution:

Hosted in a datacenter:

- Metadata
- Data
- INSPIRE-Services

Benefits:

- INSPIRE SDI
- Guarantee the quality and availability of services
- Templates makes the implementation easier
