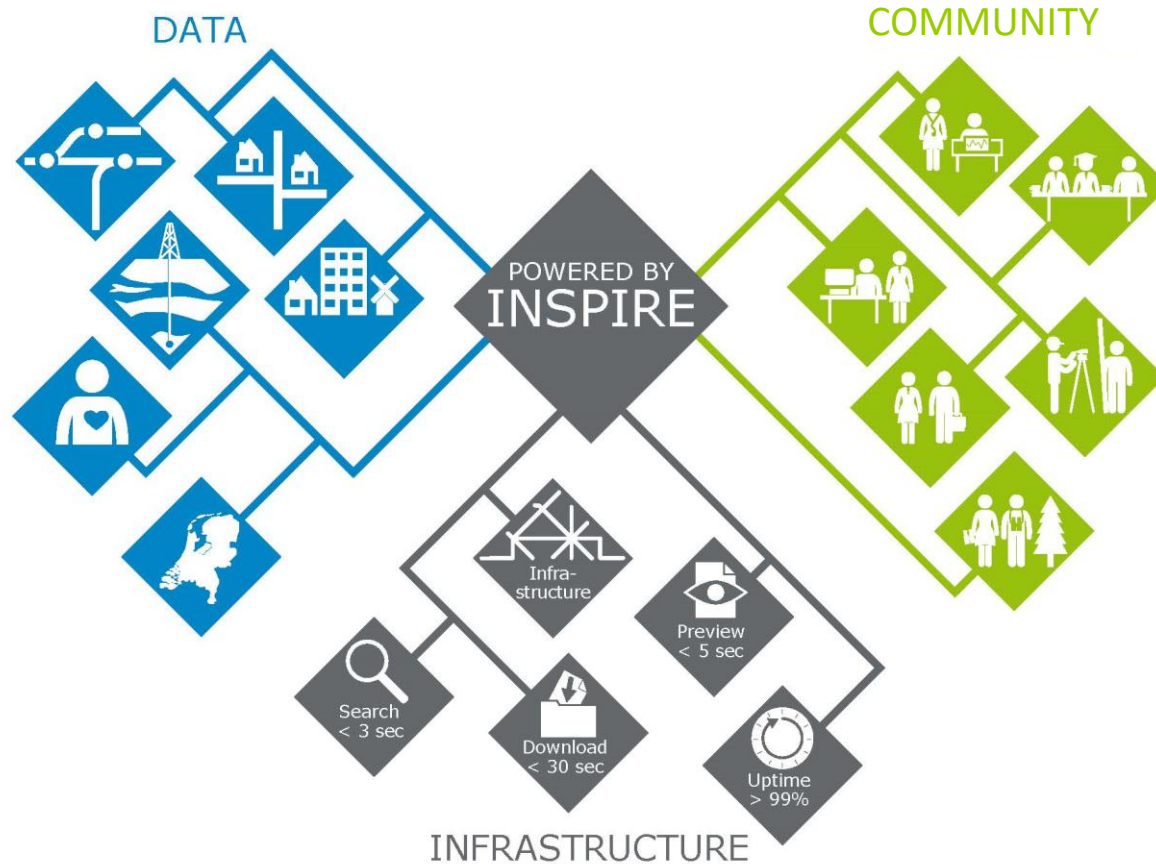

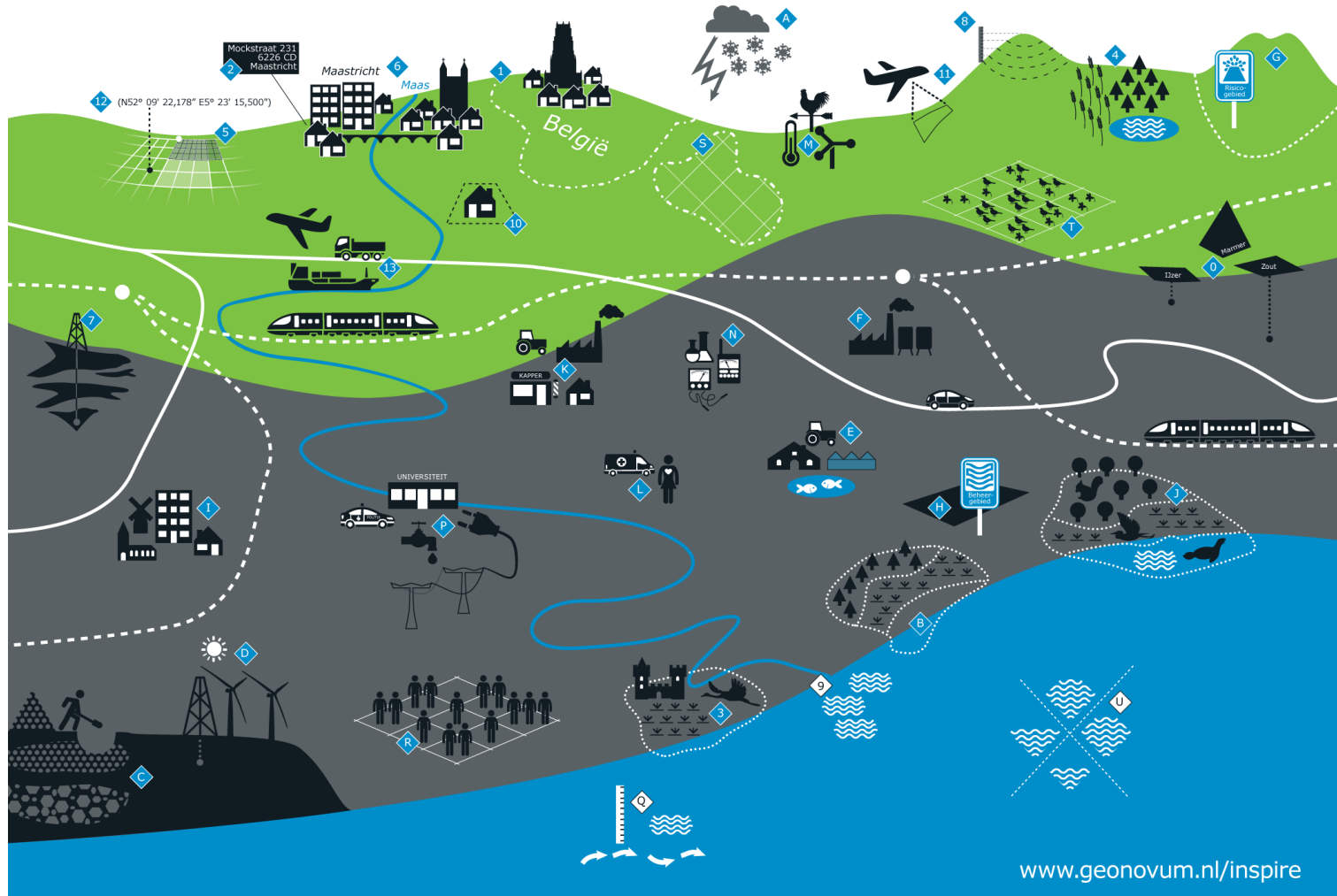

Tips for the Green Deal dataspace

- INSPIRE is/was supply driven and not demand driven:
 - Apply a user-driven approach by setting up Green Deal dataspace
- INSPIRE is technical complex and perceived as difficult to use:
 - The Green Deal data space should focus on:
easy to use (no specific technical requirements / use out of the box solutions)
- In the Netherlands almost all INSPIRE data is open data but that isn't for all Member States:
 - More synergy with High value datasets (Open Data directive)
- INSPIRE is at this moment not the basis for pan-European datasets
 - Publish data once, use many times;
 - Mandatory use of the Green Deal data by EU commission and other EU institutions (for example Eurostat, EEA)
